



Demolition of Bank Vault – Standard Chartered Nakornthon Bank

The demolition and removal of the existing cash vault was an integral part of the total refurbishment of the head office branch of Standard Chartered Nakornthon Bank.

Due to the specialist nature of these works the Project Management team preferred to let the demolition package as a separate contract prior to the fit out of the new banking facility.

Hammersmith successfully pre-qualified and won the demolition contract in open, competitive bidding.

In the four week contract period all existing finishes were stripped out, the vault door “surgically” removed for re-use and the heavily reinforced vault structure cut by diamond wall sawing and stitch drilling into app. 60 No. 1000 kg pieces for disposal.

Additional structural works included the re-concreting of the mezzanine slab, concrete stair construction and general builders works.
