Extreme loads from vehicles with axle weights up to 196,000 kg caused severe damage to expansion joints and general concrete surfaces in the scrap metal storage area of Hecket Multiserve at Siam Strip Mill.

After a number of failed attempts by the main contractor and owner to carry out repairs with traditional concrete repair mortars. Hammersmith were contacted to propose a long term solution to the problem.
